Airport Pick Up	All exchange students are required to arrive at Fort Smith Regional Airport (FSM) . Our staff will meet students at the airport and take them to UAFS campus free of charge. Students are required to fill out the Arrival Information Form (available on application website) and submit to us after obtaining flight itinerary. For safety concerns, all exchange students must be picked up by OIR staff and return to on-campus housing immediately following arrival.
Language	All courses are conducted in English.
Courses available to exchange students	Almost all courses are potentially available as long as the student meets the prerequisites. List of all courses: https://slbanformsp01.uafs.edu:8888/pls/PRODDAD/hxskschd.FS_P_Schedule Students will receive an email about course selection around one to two months before the semester starts.
Restricted courses	There are some special topics courses not available to exchange students. Exchange students are not allowed to take more than one full online classes.
Required number of credits each semester	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Min. 12 credit hours; Max. 13 credit hours • Exchange students are not allowed to take more than one full online class.
Accuplacer Test	Students are required to take Accuplacer Tests (English Writing, English Reading, and Mathematics). If students do not obtain the required scores, they may be asked to retake the tests or be enrolled in less than 12 credit hours in the first semester to build up their skill sets in order to be successful in classes.
Compulsory language requirements for exchange students (only ONE)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TOEFL (61 IBT, 500 PBT) • IELTS (5.5 or above) We may accept other forms of English proficiency proof. Please check with OIR for more information.
Health insurance requirements	All exchange students MUST purchase health insurance covering the whole period of study through UAFS.
