Orientation Dates


Fall Semester August 11 - 12, 2025 Spring Semester January 14 - 15, 2026

Orientation is mandatory for all international students.

Application process

- 1. All applicants are required to apply ONLINE and upload all application materials **BEFORE** the application deadline.
- 2. OIR processes the applications and releases admission results to applicants via email.
- 3. OIR will email Acceptance Letter and DS-2019 to accepted students.
- 4. Students will start the J-1 visa application process.
- 5. Students will receive the UAFS login information via email.



Course Selection

UAFS courses are conducted in English.

Most courses are available to exchange students as long as the prerequisites are met. List of all courses:

There are some special topics courses not available to exchange students.

Students will receive an email about course selection around one to two months before the semester starts.

Required no. of credits per semester



Min. 12 credit hours; Max. 13 credit hours

Exchange students are not allowed to take more than one fully online class.

Accuplacer Tests

UAFS uses Accuplacer Tests to make course placement decisions and set students up for success.

Students are required to take Accuplacer Tests (English Writing, English Reading, Mathematics) BEFORE or AFTER arrival.

After the tests, students will be scheduled to meet with academic advisors to finalize their class schedule.

If students do not obtain the required scores, they may be asked to retake the tests or be enrolled in less than 12 credit hours in the first semester to build up their skills.

Final decision of class enrollment rests on UAFS.



All exchange students are required to arrive at Fort Smith Regional Airport (FSM).

OIR staff will meet students at the airport and take them to UAFS campus free of charge.

For safety concerns, all exchange students must be picked up by OIR staff and return to on-campus housing immediately following arrival.

Students are required to fill out the Arrival Information Form (available on the application website) and send their flight itinerary.



All exchange students MUST purchase health insurance through UAFS.

The International Student Health Insurance from UAFS is in compliance with the U.S. Federal requirements.

Students can decide whether they want to purchase additional insurance from their home countries.

The insurance coverage is August 1 to December 31 for Fall semester and January 1 to July 31 for Spring semester.

All exchange students are required to stay in on-campus housing.

Students can apply for on-campus housing AFTER they are accepted to UAFS.

Students will receive the UAFS login information via email to login to the Housing Application.

Students are responsible for Housing, Meals, Books, Health Insurance, plus Personal Expenses while studying in UAFS.

Estimated cost of study Per Semester in USD : \$5,930 (personal expenses are not included)

Here is the breakdown-

<u>Tuition</u>: Waived under exchange agreement <u>Fees</u>: Waived under exchange agreement <u>Housing</u>: \$2,450 (Lion's Den, double room) <u>Meals</u>: \$2,060 (on campus meal plan, unlimited meals) <u>Books</u>: \$700 <u>Health Insurance</u>: \$120 per month (approx. \$720 per semester)

Students are required to provide a bank statement showing proof of financial resources for visa application. For one semester, the amount shown on financial document needs to be at least \$5,930.

Other one-time fees Application Fee: \$50 Tuberculosis Test: \$60 New Student Orientation Fee: \$75 Please note that other mandatory fees may be applied. For more information, please contact OIR.

Frequently Asked Questions

Visa and Employment

Do I need to pay for the SEVIS I-901 fee?

Yes. You are required to pay for the SEVIS I-901 fee to the Department of Homeland Security as part of the J-1 visa application. It is not the J-1 visa application processing fee. For the current amount of the SEVIS I-901 fee and other information, please visit <u>https://www.ice.gov/sevis/i901</u>

In order to get your student visa, you must present proof of your I-901 SEVIS Fee payment at your visa interview. The printed confirmation will serve as proof of payment for the I-901 SEVIS Fee. Please make sure to print a receipt of payment after you have completed your I-901 payment.

Can I work while studying as a J-1 exchange student in UAFS?

You are not allowed have any paid employment. However, you can take an unpaid internship. You may also volunteer at a local nonprofit charitable organization.

Can I apply for Social Security Number (SSN)? You are eligible to apply for SSN only if you have an internship.

Can I get a driver's licenses? Yes.

Can I travel outside of the United States while studying as a J-1 exchange student? Yes, but you need to have a travel signature on the DS2019 in order to return to the U.S.

Frequently Asked Questions Period of Stay

Can I study for more than one semester in UAFS? Yes. UAFS has four semesters: Fall (August – December); Spring (January – May); Summer I (June); Summer II (July)

Can I study for one whole academic year? Yes, it will be Fall and Spring semesters.

Can I stay for Summer semesters?

Yes, exchange students can stay for Summer I and/or Summer II. Students are required to stay on-campus during Summer semesters and are not required to take any classes. If students register for classes in Summer, their tuition and fees will not be waived. However, we can sometimes offer scholarships to students who obtain a good GPA in his/her previous semester if they want to take any classes in Summer semesters.

What should I do if I want to extend my exchange study after starting the semester? Please contact OIR and your home institution to find out whether you are eligible for the extension.

Finance

When do I need to pay for the balance in the student account?

Exchange students are usually required to pay off the balance before the end of the Orientation Week. However, the payment deadline differs each semester. Please ensure to check with OIR for the update payment deadline.

What do I need to pay?

Exchange students pay for application fee at the time of the application. During the study at UAFS, students pay for housing, meals, books, insurance, and personal expenses. For the first semester, students will also pay for the Tuberculosis Test Fee and Orientation Fee.

Can I pay by international credit card? Yes.

How can I pay? You can pay online via the UAFS portal.

Can I open a bank account after arrival?

Yes. We can take you to the bank and open a bank account. It is free to open an account.

Frequently Asked Questions Arrival (I)

Can I arrive before the arrival period?

It is highly discouraged for students to arrive before the arrival period. Campus may not be open for some dates outside of the arrival period and airport pickup service may not be available. Students may be able to move into on-campus housing before the arrival period but will need to pay for each additional night.

Can I arrive after the arrival period?

It is highly discouraged. Students need to attend the mandatory orientation. If students arrive after the arrival period, they will not have enough time to take the Accuplacer tests and it will affect students' final course selection.

Can I arrive in another airport apart from Fort Smith Regional Airport (FSM)?

Please avoid choosing another airport for arrival. Our airport pick up service is only available for students arriving at Fort Smith Regional Airport (FSM). If you arrive at another airport, you will need to arrange transportation to Fort Smith. Transportation between cities can be inconvenient and costly.

Can I have my friends to pick me up at the airport?

You can have your friends greet you at the airport. However, you must be picked up by OIR staff and return to UAFS campus upon arrival.

Frequently Asked Questions Arrival (II)

Can I stay off campus? No, all exchange students are required to stay on campus.

Will temporary bedding be available in the room on the day of my arrival? Yes, please make a request if you need the Housing Office to provide temporary bedding for you on the first day. It is free of charge.

Will I be able to go to the store to buy the daily necessities? Yes, OIR will arrange shopping trip for you on the first or second day of your arrival.

Will I be able to buy a phone card?

Yes. Please make sure your phone is compatible with a U.S. sim card.

Can I skip Orientation or leave early during Orientation? No. You must attend the whole Orientation and cannot leave early before the sessions finish.

Frequently Asked Questions Enrollment

How can I register for classes?

For the first semester, students will receive an email notifying them to select classes around one to two months before the semester starts. After the first semester, students will make appointments with the academic advisors to register for classes.

Can I change my classes after arriving at UAFS?

Yes, you can change your classes when you meet with the academic advisors during Orientation Week.

How many classes can I take?

Exchange students can take minimum of 12 credit hours and maximum of 13 credit hours for each Fall and Spring semester. Normally, one class consists of 3 credit hours.

Can I receive an official transcript after each semester or the completion of exchange study? Yes, you can request the official transcript from UAFS Registrar's Office.
