Instruction Language	Chinese / English
Credit hours per Semester (TCU Credits)	At TCU, each course is normally worth 2-3 credits and meets 2-3 hours per week over 18 weeks (one semester). 1 credit = 1 hour per week over 18 weeks, 1 credit = 18 hours Approximately 1 TCU credit = 2 ECTS credits 1 TCU credit = 1 credit hour (North American credit system)

Application Procedure and Documents	《Step 1 Eligibility》 Home Institution Exchanges to TCU are only possible if your school has an exchange program to TCU and if you have been selected by your university. Please check with your school to see if they offer exchanges to TCU and what procedures you need to complete the selection. Application Deadline Once your home institution has selected you for an exchange, you must apply for TCU's exchange program. Please complete the application steps stated as follows and return it to your exchange advisor at your home institution. Please be aware of the TCU application deadlines for the semester/academic year you are applying. 《Step 2 Online Application》 1: Complete the application form and attach all the required documents as follows: - An official English transcript from home university (PDF); - A photocopy of passport information page (JPG); - An English or Chinese autobiography – at least 500 words (PDF); - An English or Chinese study plan & statement of purpose – at least 500 words (PDF); - A passport-sized color photo (JPG) - A Chinese Proficiency Evaluation (if applicable, only for students who have studied Chinese before) - Health Insurance - Certificate of Enrollment or equivalent Online application for Spring 2026 Exchange Program: https://forms.gle/iq9QeeUyQrdHiDpX9 2: Your school administrator should submit the nomination to us before the application deadline. 3: Only successful applications will receive an admission notification from us.

Insurance	International students are required to purchase insurance in their own country during their stay in Taiwan. Accident insurance is MANDATORY for all incoming exchange students. Students are requested to join an accident insurance plan as



	recommended by TCU. Students are required to purchase an insurance plan during the first week after arrival. -Accident and Health Insurance: TCU will assist you in acquiring health insurance coverage in Taiwan, which costs NT\$3,000 for a period of six months before you can join the National Health Insurance. -Student Group Insurance: The policy covers medical treatment, surgery and hospitalization caused by accidents only. Additional NT\$332 per semester. 《ARC》 If you hold an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) and have met the six-month minimum residency requirement, you can choose to join the National Health Insurance (NHI) with limited coverage. A valid NHI card (National Health Insurance card) can be considered an equivalent insurance.
On-Campus Dormitory	USD 275/NTD 8,200 (Per semester/student) All international students will be provided with on-campus dormitory-style housing, which costs about \$USD 275/ NTD 8,200 per semester per student. Each room accommodates four students.
Arrival date	All exchange students are required to arrive TCU at least 3 days before the semester starts. Please arrive at Taoyuan International airport around noon time since it takes more than 4 hours to arrive at our campus. Please keep your cell phone available and arrive at our campus on the recommended date to match the opening of the accommodation. NOTE: Please let us know if your arrival date/time differs from suggested by TCU.

Before You Begin Your Exchange	
《1.Visa application》 Before you come to Taiwan, you should apply for a Resident or Visitor Visa at the Taiwan Diplomatic Center in your residence country with the official admission letter issued by TCU. Please note that if you fail to obtain a correct visa issued by a Taiwan Diplomatic Mission, your exchange program will be canceled. You will get more information upon receipt of a TCU offer letter. Note: There is no “Student Visa” in Taiwan. Instead, Taiwan offers 2 types of Visas for foreign students: 1. Visitor Visa, 2. Resident Visa. If you are going to stay less than 6 months, you should apply for the visitor visa. If your program is longer than 6 months, you will need to apply for the resident visa.
