

NOMINATION DEADLINE



Semester 1 (Fall/Autumn)	September – December	24th April 2026
Semester 2 (Spring)	January – April/May	6th October 2026
Full Academic Year	September – April/May	24th April 2026

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Students must be formally nominated via email by their sending institution/study abroad office. We require the following information:



- First Name and Surname (as in their passport)
- Date of Birth (in DD/MM/YYYY format)
- Gender (as in their passport)*
- Email Address
- Current area of study
- Proposed length of study at CCCU (Semester 1/Semester 2 or Full Academic Year)

REQUIREMENTS




GPA of 2.75 or above

Good Level of English (B2 or equivalent)

Formal recognition of language ability will be required to produce a CAS in support of a Student Route Visa which all students coming for the full academic year will need.

FEES

For those students coming via a Fee-Paying Study Abroad route, the cost per Semester will be £4,000 with a £250 programme fee. The semester tuition fee and programme related costs will be £4,250.



For those students coming via the Exchange Route, there will be a £250 programme fee. This is to be paid upon notification of acceptance. There will be no further tuition related fees.

Students wishing to study with us for the academic year will be responsible for applying for a Student Route Visa and assuming all associated costs. More information can be found [here](#).

COURSE INFORMATION

Students will be required to select 4 modules per semester. Each module is worth 10 BSSP Credits meaning students will complete a minimum of 40 BSSP Credits per semester.



Institutions will be sent an updated Course Catalogue to help students select their modules by the beginning of May (tbc). They will be asked to select 10 choices (ranking in order of preference) which they will agree with their home coordinator. Once these choices have been agreed, they will be required to upload these to an online form, which they will be sent around July/August.

ACCOMMODATION

On-campus housing is mandatory for all inbound study abroad students.

We offer competitively priced accommodation in university residences and homestay. Accommodation costs range in price per week depending on the type of accommodation selected. Please see below for 2025/26 prices to provide you with an idea of the price range:




<u>Accommodation Type</u>	<u>Price</u>
Single Room, Shared Bathroom	From £150 per week
Larger Single Room, Shared Bathroom	From £170 per week
Premium Single Room, Own Bathroom	From £200 per week
Homestay	From £170 per week
